Your generous donations and commitment to United Way of Dutchess County made possible:

- 160,713 visits by our friends, neighbors and colleagues to the 24 food programs across the entire county
- 4,000 mothers and children benefited from information on healthy development
- 2,314 facilitations for county residents to receive much needed medical care
- 8,435 referrals and information for individuals and families looking for help through calls to the Hudson Valley Region 2-1-1 free helpline
- \$616,777 in Earned Income Tax Credits for 401 Dutchess County taxpayers who received free tax preparation services from the CASH Coalition. These Credits made about a \$1 million impact on the local economy

When you gave to the United Way of Dutchess County Community Fund in 2008 you helped more than 48,000 people in our county – that is 1 in 6 of your friends, neighbors, co-workers, and maybe even family members, receive assistance from United Way-supported programs.

Every 11 minutes you helped a family acquire food and other basic needs; sheltered a woman and her children in a haven safe from an abuser; helped a parent keep their utilities on or pay back rent; or aided a low-income resident in receiving free tax preparation by the Hudson Valley CASH Coalition and to take advantage of the Earned Income Tax Credit due them.

Almost every dollar you donated to United Way of Dutchess County's Community Fund was spent locally to fund over 30 United Way-supported programs and partnerships. By giving United, we as a community accomplish more since United Way of Dutchess County brings nonprofit organizations together to address issues that no one organization can tackle alone. And by working United we fulfill our mission to build a stronger, healthier community by raising resources and developing partnerships that make a measurable difference in people's lives.

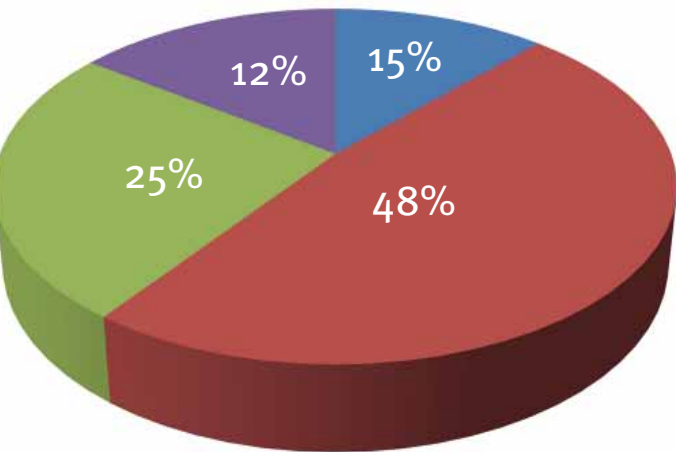
