During the last year, through our Days of Sharing program, more than \$100,000 worth of clothing and household items were distributed to more than 40 nonprofits in Dutchess and Orange Counties. Donations are received through local businesses including Bed, Bath and Beyond and Woodbury Commons Premium Outlets.

ORANGE COUNTY FUEL FUND

On an annual basis, in partnership with Orange County Government, United Way provides direct financial assistance to low income families through a one-time fuel grant. Funding is restricted to families whose income is just above the social service HEAP benefit level and who reside in Orange County, Last winter, the Fuel Fund contributed almost \$55,000 to keep 372 households warm.

EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM

To ensure that the most basic necessities are provided to families in our community, United Way chairs the local board of the Emergency Food and Shelter Program in both Dutchess and Orange Counties, providing hundreds of thousands of dollars to food pantries, feeding programs and soup kitchens.
